### Annual Action Plan 2018

January 1, 2019 - December 31, 2019 Adopted 4.9.2019

1. Pass a Climate Emergency Resolution in support of the net zero Fairfax Climate Action Plan (CAP)
2. Complete CAP Update with a vision statement reflective of net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2030
3. Recommend ordinances and resolutions to the Fairfax Town Council for the purpose of achieving zero greenhouse emissions by 2030
4. Support Fairfax Town operations becoming carbon neutral
5. Draft vulnerability assessment related to climate change risks
6. Support local and county climate change events and related actions
7. Support efforts to Electrify Everything and optimize energy efficiency
8. Support and promote transportation as a service
9. Support Community Projects and Programs
  - a. Marin Clean Energy. Encourage households to switch to Deep Green electricity (ERM 17 –73.1 GHG)
  - b. Sustainable Fairfax: ReduceX2 low carbon transportation program; Composting of Food and Green Waste. Promoting reusables over single use. (ERM 23 – 371.7 GHG).
  - c. Resilient Neighborhoods: Encourage and assist every Fairfax household and business to measure and reduce their carbon emissions (ERM 34 - GHG)
