SUBJECT: Approve temporary road and parking lot closure for the Car Show on Sunday, September 9, 2018

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the temporary closure of Broadway between Pacheco and Bolinas from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and of the entire Parkade from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 9, 2018 for the Fairfax Car Show.

DISCUSSION

For many years, the Car Show has requested and the Town has approved the temporary closure of Broadway from Pacheco to Bolinas Road, and reserved the entire Parkade to hold the annual car show, to safely facilitate the exhibition of classic cars. The organizers are requesting the same this year. The portion of Broadway from Pacheco to Bolinas will leave access to the Fairfax Theater parking lot. The approval does not cover staff overtime, if needed for the event.
