SUBJECT: Adopt a resolution declaring a police vehicle as surplus and authorizing its disposal by public auction

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution declaring the Police Department's 2007 "Go-4" 3-wheel parking vehicle as surplus, and authorize its disposal by public auction.

DISCUSSION

The Police Department has a 2007 "Go-4" 3-wheel parking buggy that is being replaced by a recently approved lease purchase of a new model. The original intent was to retain the 2007 model as a "back-up" parking enforcement vehicle. This vehicle however just suffered a failed transmission. The cost to repair it would be roughly \$7,700.00. The Police Department will not be fixing this vehicle and therefore requests authorization for its disposal.

It is customary procedure to declare by resolution such vehicles as surplus for disposal.
