RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSSION

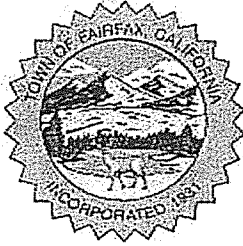
