SUBJECT: Discuss/consider award of contract for the Tamalpais/Mountain View Pavement Rehabilitation project

RECOMMENDATION

Discuss/consider award of contract for the Tamalpais/Mountain View pavement rehabilitation project and either

- 1) Award contract to the lowest responsible bidder, or
- 2) Reject all bids.

DISCUSSION

As the project bids were opened on Friday, September 1st at 2:00pm, staff did not have time to determine who the lowest responsible bidder was prior to the publication of the agenda packet. A supplemental staff report identifying the lowest responsible bidder will be distributed prior to the Council meeting.

This project was initially planned for FY16-17. The project entails repaving Tamalpais Road from Mountain View to Scenic Rd and Mountain View Road from Manzanita Road to Tamalpais Road. The work generally consists of full width grind and asphalt concrete overlay, digout repairs, adjustment of utility covers to grade, and striping along Tamalpais Road and Mountain View Roads.

However, the project was put on hold in FY16-17 because of PG&E's gas line replacement project. PG&E has contributed \$52,301 towards this repavement project in lieu of PG&E repaving just portions of the road it worked in. The project was re-budgeted in the current fiscal year, but has been delayed pending the Ross Valley Sewer District (RVSD) pipeline replacement project. RVSD indicated their project will be completed in mid-September. With that date in mind, the Town bid out this project in August with a bid opening on September 1.

FISCAL IMPACT

The project is being funded with a combination of TAM Measure A and PG&E funds.
