SUBJECT: Adoption of a Resolution Declaring Town Owned Police Department Vehicles as Surplus to the Needs of the Town and Authorizing the Police Department to Dispose of Same by Public Auction

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the resolution declaring three Police Department vehicles as surplus, and authorize sale by public auction.

DISCUSSION

The Town periodically must acquire new vehicles to replace those that are no longer serviceable. The Police Department is cycling out three vehicles: a 1998 Buick and two 2007 Ford Crown Victoria police cars. These vehicles will be declared as surplus.

It is customary procedure to declare by Resolution such vehicles as surplus, and dispose of them through public auction or bid.

FISCAL IMPACT

The sale of all three vehicles will provide approximately \$7500 to the general fund. The replacement vehicles have already been leased utilizing budgeted funds.
