.New Business

- 1. Spring Fling Family Bingo Night- Terri Rose attended the meeting to request sponsorship of a benefit for the YES Foundation in the Pavilion on April 27th. Terri has a 8 year old daughter who is in the 3rd grade at Manor School, and has partnered with some of the other parents to host a bingo night as a fundraiser. She asked that the 30% proceeds of the event go directly to the YES Foundation, since they are the non-profit that will benefit from the event. ACTION ITEM: Sisi made a motion to approve the Spring Fling Family Bingo Night; Sam seconded; all Commissioners voted in favor of approving the event. Terri was informed she will still have to pay the \$325 cleaning fee.
- 2. <u>Peri Park Playground Renovation Project</u> Anne announced that Garrett has hired an architect to produce the base map. Sam said he will begin working on the thermometer prop which will show and measure fundraising efforts for the playground structure. Jennifer Lazzarini, Playground Consultant was unable to attend tonight's meeting, but will instead come to the April meeting.
- 3. Re-cap of Alice in Wonderland Tea- Maria reported that a total of 66 tickets were sold, result in \$839 in ticket sales. Attendance was at an all-time high. Sam expressed interested in holding the event in the Pavilion in the future, as they have outgrown the space in the Women's Club. This will allow them to have even more attendees.
