Thank you for your interest in Camp Fairfax Counselor in Training program. Enclosed with this letter are the program overview, and application. Space in our CIT program is limited so it is imperative that you are 12 - 15 years old (please don't apply if you are younger or older), and that you submit your application by the **deadline of June 14**, 2019. We will not accept applications after this date.

The Counselor in Training program offers unique opportunities for developing personal and professional skills while encouraging you to enjoy the natural beauty and wonder of our sweet town. The program is designed to help create a scaffolding of ages from our community whereby young campers can connect and collaborate with older counselors in training. It is important that CIT demonstrate positive role modeling, leadership, communication and exemplary understanding of the supervision of children in a camp setting.

Our CIT program is for 12 – 15 year olds—middle school and early high school students. The program has mandatory training days on July 25 and 26 of 2019.

After our staff reviews applications, you will be notified to come in for an interview. Interviews are planned for week of July 8, 2019 this year. CIT's <u>accepted</u> into our program will get a weekly stipend based on our budget. It usually is 50.00/week for your service.

Counselor in Training Behavioral Guidelines

Our Counselor in Training are valued members of our Camp Fairfax season. CIT's are representatives of the Town of Fairfax. As a CIT, you will be expected to uphold our highest standards of behavior.

COUNSELORS IN TRAINING WILL:

- **Be Prepared:** pay attention during the training days so you know the flow of camp and the details of what is expected of you. Ask questions if you aren't sure about something.
- **Be Friendly:** make friends with other CITs, the counselors and campers. Having positive attitude at camp is very important!
- **Be Responsible**: show up on time and stay on site for the full day of camp. Follow the camp's rules and do what is asked of you by your counselor. Understand your responsibilities and embrace them!
- **Be a Leader**: you are a role model for the campers so make sure you model good behavior. Do listen to your counselor and participate in activities. Do not use inappropriate language or behavior.
- **Be Enthusiastic**: your active participation is camp is important! Show the campers that participation does not have to be perfect; camp participation is about learning, growing as a person and having fun with others!
- **Be Caring**: Learn your campers' names. If a camper is having a bad day, listen to their needs and try to cheer them up! If someone gets hurt, tend to them and get help if needed.
- **Be Communicative:** good communication with your counselor is key to your team's success. Make sure you keep engaged with your campers and relay anything that may be a problem to your counselor. Give feedback to your counselor about what worked well and didn't work that day.
- LEAVE THEIR CELL PHONES IN A BASKET DURING THEIR WORKING SHIFT

COUNSELORS IN TRAINING ALSO NEED TO...

- Know your personal boundaries and be able to enforce campers' understanding of personal boundaries. You are a role model and an example of good behavior to campers.
- Always travel in groups of three's and never be alone with a camper. If a camper
 forgot something and needs to retrieve it, take another CIT or counselor with you.
 Do not go into the private bathroom or bathroom stall with a camper. If an
 accident has occurred, and the camper has asked for help, only a counselor of the
 same gender can help the camper.

• You are responsible for reporting any suspicious behavior. Tell the Director immediately if someone or something seems very unusual or alarming. If a child tells you that violence is happening at home, you are mandated to report it to the Director and Child Protective Services (CPS).

Any Counselor in Training who exhibit any of the following behaviors will be promptly excused from the camp.

- Violent acts against other campers, staff, parents or themselves.
- Theft or vandalism.
- Possession of alcohol, narcotics or dangerous drugs.
- Possession of a weapon.
- Overt sexual behavior towards campers, staff or parents.
- Unsupervised activities involving fire, including smoking.
- Use of foul language or gestures.
- Bullying of other campers, C.I.T's or staff will not be tolerated.

MANDATORY ARBITRATION OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE TOWN. It is hereby expressly understood an agreed to by the undersigned that any claim asserted against the Town by the undersigned participant, either on behalf of him/her or on behalf of another person, on account of bodily injury, mental disturbance, death or property damage, sustained as a result of, or for any reason connected to the use of Town property, facilities or programs or acts or omissions of Town employees or volunteers pursuant to this registration, will be resolved by submission to arbitration as provided by California law, and not by a lawsuit or resort to court process except as California law provides for judicial review of arbitration proceedings. It is agreed that all claim submission, requirements, procedures, and deadlines and all immunities established by the Government Code or other provision of law will apply, but that the undersigned waives all rights to file a lawsuit and agrees, in lieu thereof, to resolving all claims and disputes through the arbitration process. The Town and the undersigned, by execution of this document, are giving up their constitutional right to have any such dispute decided in a court of law and before a judge or jury and instead are accepting the use of arbitration.
