The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the April 15th meeting were approved.

New Business

1. **Peri Park playground renovation project**-Doug Gorley attended the meeting to sell components that are needed for the Peri Park new playground structures. His company, Pacific Playgrounds, will sell events separately, without having to install them. The structures that are being requested for the small playground include: climbing wall, log climber (this will be built so no need to order); ramp (this will be built so no need to order); wobbly bridge (this will be built so no need to order). The structures that are being requested for the big playground include: swivel bridge, rings, and climbing wall. The group looked over the catalogs and picked out 5 specific structures, and asked Doug to get back to them on the pricing. The structures are: Lily Pad Weave, Trapeze Ring Ladder 5 ft., Concentration Climber, 4 ft. gated, Concentration Climber, 6 ft. gated, and Concentration Climber, 8 ft. gated.

Peri Park clean-up & fundraiser-The May 18th Peri Park clean-up event is scheduled for 10 a.m. The hot dog bbq fundraiser with the firefighters will begin at 12 noon. Dennise will sell t-shirts & tote bags outside of the Community Center.

2. **Citizen of the Year award**- Maria distributed an application form she created using existing forms from the City of San Rafael and the City of Novato. Alexis suggested removing the question “What obstacles has this person faced in carrying out their work?”. Maria will then have Camille re-format the form and send it to Mayor Barbara Coler for approval. The form will be released on June 1st, posted on the Town’s website. The deadline for submittals will be August 1st. PARC will look over the applications at its August meeting, and then forward to the Mayor for selection in September.

3. **Measure A Representative** – Chris Borjian attended the Measure A meeting on April 22nd. He was happy to report that the \$10,000 allocated for the bike pump track was diverted to the Peri Park Renovation Project, bringing the overall total to \$80K in funds for the Peri Park Playground Renovation Project (over a 3 year funding period).

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m. The next meeting was scheduled for June 10th.
