- September 20-27, global climate strikes planned (from school and work), with actions throughout the week including march in SF. Greta Thunberg expected to attend. Details on 350 Marin website.
- 350 Marin offering and event on "Good Grief" (10-week online support group for processing and acting on climate issues, dealing with depression, anxiety, etc.)
- Thursday, September 5, in Pt. Reyes Main Street Moms presentation on gerrymandering in evening get flyer from Kiki
- David: reported on Sustainable Marin gathering at their house, discussing ideas on how to generate county-wide and higher level coordinated actions
- Kiki: Marin Drawdown intends to be the prime driver of actions re: renewable energy, transportation, carbon sequestration, resilient neighborhoods, green building, policy for all. Suggested taking more ownership of Drawdown. Jody noted that Drawdown efforts tie in to CAC Action Plan goal #6, Support local and county climate change events and related actions.

- Goal #4 Carbon-neutral town operations. Looking into central solar installation to support multiple operations (microgrids); how much solar can contribute to offset carbon output; emergency planning and backup for power outages. PGE working with county on shelters in case of power shutdown. Suggested bringing community members and organizations together to talk through logistics of a multi-day shutdown; taking care of the most vulnerable in our community. Microgrid discussed for pavilion/town buildings. Pavilion currently not approved shelter site, additional FEMA funding coming, may help town bring up to standards. Present as recommendation to council. (Walt, Peter)
- Goal #5 Vulnerability assessment. What are the risks, how has town prepared? Created draft document identifying main threats (from County plan) to help people prioritize based on location of home, etc. Include info on how to prepare, with links to resources. Bruce suggested referring to Fairfax General Plan. Jody to send out copy of her draft vulnerability assessment doc for CAC to review and comment on. (Jody, Gail)
- Goal #6 Support local climate change events. No update. (All)
- Goal #7 Electrify all, optimize energy efficiency. No update. (David, Walt)
- Goal #8 Transportation. No update, subcommittee (Bruce, Gail, David) has not met. Chris would like to join subcommittee. (Bruce, David, Gail)
