WHEREAS, over the years Rainbow Fabrics has provided our community with classes and plenty of creative material; and

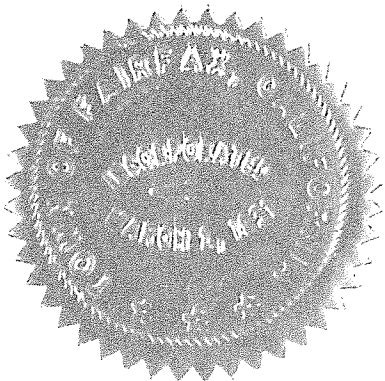
WHEREAS, Rose, through her store and her generosity, became a central thread in the fabric of our community, fostering nearly 30 children in her home together with her husband; and
