The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the January 13, 2020 meeting were approved.

New Business

1. **Skateboard park-** Steven Teigeiro attended the meeting to report that he has reached out to Council Member Stephanie Hellman and Lisa Graham regarding a proposed skate park in Fairfax. Lisa Graham was instrumental in building the skate park in San Anselmo at Memorial Park. The group has been looking at sites that might be potential locations, including privately owned lots. Some possibilities include White Hill School, and they will make an inquiry to Michael MacIntosh at the Marin Town & Country Club. Steven indicated he would prefer the skate park to be located downtown for accessibility. Sisi suggested that at this point, PARC supports the concept of the project, and Steven can return and update PARC when he has further information.
2. **Shakespeare Play in Peri Park-** Jay Cimo attended the meeting along with Peter Lacques, Larry Bragman and Patty Bredt regarding a request for sponsorship of “Ye Merry Wives of Windsor” play, produced by the *Walk in the Park Players*. They have requested the following dates for the play in Peri Park: Sept. 11, 12, 18, 19, 20, 25 & 26. All performances are from 7-10 p.m., with the exception of a Sunday matinee on September 20th. The admission will be \$20 for adults, and \$10 for youth. The group will bring in 2-3 Port-a-Potties, and would like to request that the restrooms in Peri Park remain open. Coffee and baked goods will be sold. **ACTION ITEM: Sam made a motion to approve the play, Eric seconded; all Commissioners voted in favor.**
3. **Peri Park Playground Renovation update-** Anne announced that Mark Woodrow has been hired as the structural engineer. It will take approximately 2-3 weeks for him to submit the plans. Maria has been tasked with finding the manufacturer of the previous playground equipment and acquiring specifications for the events that will be re-used. Maria announced that the Fairfax Volunteers will host a Talent Showcase on Friday, May 29th from 6-9 at the Women’s Club,

similar to last year. This year, the proceeds from that event will be donated to the Peri Park Playground Renovation Project.

4. **Dates for 2020 events**—the following dates have been scheduled for PARC events:

- Saturday March 7th Alice in Wonderland Tea 2-3:30 Women's Club
- Saturday April 11th Spring Egg Hunt 10 a.m. Bolinas Park
- Saturday & Sunday, June 13 & 14- Fairfax Festival

No date has been secured yet for the Speakcheesey event, which will occur in the fall.

5. **Goals for 2020-** the group decided that the Renovation of Peri Park will remain the primary goal of PARC for this year.
