The minutes of the February 10, 2020 meeting were approved.

.New Business

- 1. Spring Egg Hunt- Maria announced that the Spring Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, April 11th at 10 a.m. at Bolinas Park. She will have her folks stuff the eggs with candy. Commissioners will meet at 9:15 a.m. to hide the eggs. David Smadbeck will once again be the emcee. Maria will ask James K to play music and see if the Bubble Man is available, as well as Tatyana for face painting. She will send out a reminder to PARC when it is closer to the event.
- 2. Music in the Park series- Kyle Alden, Robert Kennedy and David Smadbeck attended the meeting to request sponsorship of the music series again this year. The dates that are being proposed are July 19, July 26, August 2, August 23, August 30, and September 6th (which is Labor Day weekend). All dates are on Sundays, times of performance will be 3-6 p.m. They will provide chairs for the attendees. Sisi inquired about the July 19th date, because the Fairfax Theater Company will be holding a matinee performance of their summer play in the Pavilion. There did not seem to be a concern of noise interference between the two events. Robert announced they have asked Marin Baroque to be the non-profit sponsor of the event this year in order to pay the musicians. ACTION ITEM: Sisi made a motion to approve the proposed Music in the Park series, Chris seconded; all Commissioners voted in favor.
- **3.** Peri Park Playground Renovation update- Anne announced that Mark Woodrow will submit the plans this Wednesday. The next step will be for Coastland to review the plans.
- **4.** <u>Dine-N-Donate</u>—Maria announced that Myles Morford of The Hub restaurant in San Anselmo has reached out to her regarding holding a fundraiser for Peri Park. The event will be on Thursday, April 2nd. A total of 10% of the evenings net sales

will benefit Peri Park, once \$2,000 in profit has been made. Camille developed a flyer for the event, which Maria distributed to the group.

5. Recap of Alice in Wonderland tea- Maria reported there were 67 attendees, and a total of \$681 was collected at the event, not including the Evenbrite ticket sales. Next year all of the ticket sales will be run through Eventbrite.
