



Dear Town of Fairfax Recreation Community,

I am writing to inform you that the Town of Fairfax Recreation Department will be closing all of our Recreation programs, special events and facility rentals, including partnership programs, such as, Flying Dutchman Gymnastics, **starting Monday, March 16 until Tuesday, April 7**, as a precaution against the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). We are removing all toys from Peri Park for public health reasons. We have updated each activity on our website with the current status and will continue to do so throughout the upcoming weeks. We will send an update by **Monday April 6**, regarding the reopening of the Recreation programs, special events and facility rentals.

There are no known cases of diagnosed coronavirus (COVID-19) among Town of Fairfax staff or program participants currently. However, as the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation has unfolded and we gathered more information at the state and local level, it has become clear that the most responsible action, at this moment, is for us to take a proactive approach to social distancing and sheltering in place.

Town Hall and our Recreation Offices will be closed to the public during this time.
