WHEREAS, as a community we understand that economic progress and competitiveness is best served by promoting diverse, inclusive communities, with equal access to good jobs, schools, health care, transportation, and housing; and

WHEREAS, interested parties from both the private and public sectors will participate in a city, state and national effort to promote fair housing;
