Reasons why project is exempt:	
The Project is exempt under State CEQA Guidelines section 15269, which provides that "[s]pecific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency" are statutorily exempt from CEQA as the Town has become is concerned that the Bridge's collapse due to the scouring and undermining of the areas where the Bridge is attached to the banks, constitutes an imminent danger. As well, the substantially increased risk of wildfires and number of catastrophic wildfires in the Northern San Francisco Bay Area and Northern California in general, over the last three years due to the effects of climate change, pose an imminent danger of a wildfire destroying the Bridge and leaving residents of Meadow Way unable to escape the wildfire as well as firefighters unable to reach the homes on Meadow Way. The Project is also exempt under State CEQA Guidelines section 15302 for replacement of existing structures, as the Project replaces the existing Bridge.
