#### **DISCUSSION**

The Racial Equity and Social Justice Committee (RESJ) has held three virtual special meetings: November 5<sup>th</sup>, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, and December 6<sup>th</sup>. On December 6<sup>th</sup>, the RESJ held its retreat in the morning and a training session in the afternoon. At its December 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, the RESJ appointed 5 members to its Police Subcommittee. The Police Subcommittee has yet to meet, but the meetings will be open to the public. The RESJ also created an Ad-Hoc Subcommittee to develop a mission and vision statement. This subcommittee is an ad-hoc group, and its meeting will not be open to the public.

The RESJ has established the first Thursday of the month at 7:00pm to 9:30pm as its regular meeting day and time. The first regular RESJ virtual meeting is January 7, 2021.

Mayor Ackerman and Vice-Mayor Hellman, as the Council representatives on the RESJ, will provide an oral report on the RESJ to the Council at the meeting.
