SUBJECT: Adopt a Resolution Reciting the Fact of the General Election held on November 3, 2020, Declaring the Result and Such Other Matters as Provided by Law

RECOMMENDATION

Make a motion to adopt the Resolution Reciting the Fact of the General Election held on November 3, 2020, Declaring the Result and Such Other Matters as Provided by Law.

DISCUSSION

On November 3, 2020, a general election was held in the Town for the offices of three Town Council members. Out of 6054 registered Fairfax voters, 5485 voted, which is a 90.6 % turnout.

State law requires the Council to adopt a resolution to recite the fact of the election and declare the results. At the time the agenda packet was published, the final results had not yet been certified. The Registrar of Voters for Marin County certified the results earlier today, which are attached as Exhibit A to the Resolution.

FISCAL IMPACT

The current estimated cost of this consolidated election is approximately \$2.00 per registered voter. Fairfax has 6054 registered voters, which results an approximate cost of \$12,100. The Fiscal Year Budget 2020-21 allocated \$16,000 for election costs.
