### FAIRFAX TEMPORARY SKATEPARK UPDATE

#### 1. LOCATION

- A. Per February 3 staff report, a section of the Bank Street / Pavilion parking lot has been identified as the optimal location for a temporary skatepark. See staff report and attached for scope design.
- B. 3 oversized parking spots will be taken by this project.
- C. Proposed project will extend into current Compost bin. Sand bin will continue to serve community for sand (in rainy season) and compost in summer and fall.

#### 2. TIMING / SEQUENCING

- A. If approved by council on 2/17, the site will offer a legal place to skate within 48hrs until contractors, builders arrive.
- B. Designers / Builders and Contractors arrive on March 1

#### 3. CONSTRUCTION / LABOR

- A. Semi-Pro Skater Jeremy Tuffli has committed to design and build fitting this effort into his schedule. His skatepark resume includes Marin City, Mill Valley, Bolinas, several around the nation and the Vans skatepark in Mexico City.
- B. Licensed local contractor Peter Gubbins donating Fencing and Labor
  - i. Meeting with Public works for specifications on design and approval.
- C. Licensed contractor Chris Lopes of Minden Builds who grew up in Fairfax, and now lives in Novato has also offered to donate contract labor.

#### 4. COMMUNICATION

A. Community flyer attached was posted in downtown neighborhood week of February 1. See attached.


#### 5. LIABILITY / COST / FUNDRAISING

- A. None of the other 7 skate/scooterparks in Marin have experienced liability problems. All support insurance through Park and Rec insurance. This has been explored by staff and can be an "add on" at no additional cost.
- B. A "GoFundMe" fundraising site has been established. See flyer for details.
- C. Brenna Gubbins/Live Water Surfshop has committed \$5,000. Brenna is on the skatepark team.
- D. ProofLab has committed \$5,000. Resident and co-owner Will Hutchinson is on the skatepark team.
- E. Several other private donors committed amounting to a total of at least \$12,000 (not including Gubbins fencing donation).
- F. Note **NO town funds are being requested** although Measure A funds are eligible.

#### 6. NEXT STEPS

- A. Public Works walk-through will Peter Gubbins to confirm specifications on protective fencing. Targeting 2/4 or 2/5.
- B. Staff will review final park design with park safety consult town typically uses.
- C. Staff will enroll town skatepark on Feb 18, as soon as it's approved by council in Park and Rec insurance


