The month of March marks the one-year anniversary of when a global pandemic swept across the world transforming how we operate overnight.

The past year has certainly presented many challenges, both to individuals and families; big and small businesses, nonprofit organizations and small towns like Fairfax, in particular.

In order to meet the challenges presented by the COVID-19 pandemic era, the town quickly reinvented many of our programs and have seen positive new outcomes. The town was one of the first in the county to initiate the Volunteer Match to Match program, responded to small businesses with the recovery fund, safely re-opened summer camps, and created a professional Racial Equity Social Justice committee.

Additionally:

- We increased communications by offering weekly newsletters.
- We opened up the Pavilion for the Flying Dutchman Gymnastics to offer classes.
- We opened outdoor music pods for toddlers with local musician Dani Levy.
- We continued our Age Friendly free classes by offering online yoga six times a week, in person dance classes on Contratti field and outdoor yoga with proceeds going towards social justice programs.
- We celebrated our 90 + residents with carefully crafted gift baskets procured by local businesses and delivered in person by the Age Friendly Fairfax team.
- We offered virtual holiday events such as Fairfax Craft Faire and Wreathmaking.
- Provided over 100 volunteers masks and hand sanitizer helping with grocery deliveries.
- The Town Council approved a temporary skate park for our youth.
- Transformed the Mono Parking Lot into an outdoor dining area when it was allowed by the County of Marin Health order. The Chamber & the Town provided volunteers to set up, clean & disinfect dining areas, and take down tables & chairs every Thursday through Sunday.

We dedicate this season's catalog to the HEART of our downtown – our small brick and mortar businesses working so hard to keep Fairfax an amazing town. As we continue to make our town a thriving place to live, a refuge from the daily grind, a place to gather and be inspired and a source of healing and hope, we thank you for your support and generosity.

EARTH DAY CELEBRATION

A BioBlitz is an event where a group of people tries to document as many species as possible in a specific time frame. MUSIC PODS WITH DANI LEVY

Ongoing sessions starting in March

Location: Behind the Pavilion with spaced out hay bales and under lovely trees and nature during nice weather. We will move inside the Pavilion when it rains using safety protocols.

Ages 0-6 years

There are no refunds for missed classes or classes missed due to illness.

*Each enrollment comes with a free digital download of Dani's children's album which includes some of the songs we'll be singing throughout the session.

These custom pods are limited to 7 children and 1 adult per child—total of 14 participants. All adults must wear masks and socially distance to the best of their ability. We recommend that the same adult accompany the same child each session. Music with Dani is a fun and interactive music and movement time for young children and families. Dani's music session will have the children singing, dancing, rhyming, using their imagination and having fun while creating music together!

Dani has been a music teacher at several preschools in Marin County for over 10 years now, as well as leading music and movement sessions at The Fairfax Library and Bon Air Center. She taught Kindermusik classes, has completed the Music Together teacher training and has also run a summer camp for preschool aged children in Ross for several years. Dani has a Bachelor's degree in music and studied Early Childhood Education at College of Marin. She is really excited to bring her music sessions to Fairfax Recreation!





FLYING DUTCHMAN'S GYMNASTICS PROGRAM

4 – 12 year olds

Flying Dutchman Gymnastics is Marin's only entirely mobile recreational gymnastics program through a partnership with the Town of Fairfax and the recreation department. FDG teaches gymnastics to over 150 local children at the Pavilion in Fairfax. Our professional USAG certified coaches set up gymnastics equipment and teach classes, camps, birthday parties, games, festival events and more.

CAMP FAIRFAX - COUNSELOR IN TRAINING (CIT)

The CIT program offers unique opportunities for developing personal and professional skills while encouraging you to enjoy the natural beauty and wonder of our sweet town. The CIT program is for 11 – 15 year olds—middle school and early high school students. Parents must pay and register for the camp week to secure their CIT's spot. Once accepted the CIT's get a small stipend for their participation. We are accepting 2-3 CIT's for 2021 and they must commit to both weeks.

SUMMER IN FAIRFAX

Early bird deadline is July 1 for both summer camps we offer.

Any families submitting forms to us AFTER July 1, 2021, there will be a second tier registration time period and the fee will be an additional \$100.

There also will be \$20 change fee for families who need to withdrawal their child for any reason or switch their schedule.

ART AND NATURE CAMP

for children 4 -5 years (limit of 8 – 10 children) Week of July 12th Monday – Friday from 9am – 12noon

Location: behind the Pavilion with hay bales under the lovely trees and nature (with access to inside the Pavilion and the ballfield).

Cost: \$325

This camp is designed for transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten child/ren to get them comfortable for the new school year ahead. The flow of each day will include morning circle, music, storytelling and movement, snack time, and a short nature walk and art activity before pick up at 12 noon. Children will learn how to work within a group of peers, enhance listening skills with music exercises and do hands on crafts and nature exploration with skilled teachers. Please pack a water bottle and small snack for your child/ren each day. Safety protocols, such as masks and temperature checks, will be followed.

Camp Fairfax is a homegrown local camp for school aged youth going on its 12th year! During this special time of year campers and their counselors focus on the unique aspects of our little town and each other. This simple and old-style summer camp has evolved and this summer will include TWO specialized weeks with each week focusing on a theme. Week 1 will focus on the arts and week 2 will focus on the natural environment and music. We weave in teambuilding games and activities throughout each week and a highlight is our weekly Friday water play of running through sprinklers on the ballfield and balloon toss. We place heavy emphasis on community building scaffolding age ranges so campers can learn from each other and build confidence through collaboration. In addition, we have a variety of special circle times that happen throughout our camp including, storytelling, trust and kindness games.





Parks and Recreation Commission (PARC) continue its commitment to making arts more visible and supported in Fairfax. Spearheaded by the Fairfax Recreation and Community Services department, we are bringing together some exciting partnerships with Fairfax Volunteers and the Chamber of Commerce, among others, to bring the community the following art programs: Artist in Residence Collaborative- which includes the Fairfax Art Walk, Local Arts Pop Ups, and an Arts mentorship program, Public Art in the Parkade and the Fairfax Theater Company.

The yoga classes are designed for an adult age 55 or older. The theme of each class encourages beginners, and more active adults to become aware of their bodies through a gentle flow of yoga postures. Supported with a variety of props, the student is invited to explore safe alignment while improving their strength and balance. Each practice reinforces the relationship of breath with movement aiding the release of stress. The steady pace and instruction of class give students the confidence to begin or deepen a regular yoga practice.
