SUBJECT: Approve schedule for the Town Council and Planning Commission to return to in-

person meetings in September and allow for Town Board, Commissions and Commissions to return to in-person meetings beginning as soon as July

## RECOMMENDATION

Approve schedule for the Town Council and Planning Commission to return to in-person meetings in September and allow for Town Board, Committees, and Commissions to return to in-person meetings beginning as soon as July.

## **DISCUSSION**

Since April 2020, the Town has conducted virtual Council meetings due to COVID-19. With the recent reopening of the economy and high level of vaccinations in the County, all the Marin communities are considering when to return to in-person Council meetings. Staff recommends the Council and Planning Commission return to in-person meetings with their first meeting in September 2021. This will allow staff time to evaluate the hybrid approach other communities are trying, such as in-person meetings but continuing to allow virtual public comments via online platforms such as Zoom.

We are also recommending that all Town Boards, Committees, and Commissions be allowed to return to in-person regular meetings beginning as soon as July. However, if a Board, Committee, or Commission is uncomfortable with conducting in-person meetings in July and/or August, they should be allowed to delay in-person meetings until their first meeting in September.

It should be noted that Governor Newsom has set a date of October 1, 2021, for public agencies to transition back to public meetings held in full compliance with the Brown Act (i.e., no virtual public meeting).
