Every year the Council receives a report on the Town's recreational activities. The attached summary report covers the July, August, and September programs:

The Recreation and Community Services Department continues to serve the Fairfax population and beyond and provides all age groups affordable, fun programs, and opportunities to use Town facilities for gatherings and cultural events.

This summer Fairfax Recreation hosted several camps and received rental income from its partnership with Flying Dutchman Gymnastics. While our camps remain small in size, our quality of teachers and support for the children is high. It was great to be able to offer such a variety of activities to the community.

The department also offered classes during July - September. Donations remain a favorable way to support and offset expenses for our free resources and senior class offerings.

Compared to last year, we have been able to provide much more robust programming but not near the levels during pre-pandemic. With the upcoming Pavilion renovations, my hope is to maintain our class and camp offerings by operating out of different locations in town. Once renovations are complete, we will have many opportunities to optimize the new facility, and expand our programs and partnerships.
