This item was continued from October 6, 2021 meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is developing a scope, schedule, and budget estimate for making the temporary skate park established in conformance with Resolution No. 21-08 a permanent Town facility at that location.

BACKGROUND

At its January 20th, 2021 meeting, the Council discussed a residents' petition regarding the establishment of skate/scooter park. After taking public comment and discussing the matter, the Council directed Staff to send the request to evaluate sites for a permanent skate/scooter park location to the Parks and Recreation Commission ("PARC") for analysis and recommendation and, assigned Vice Mayor Hellman and Councilmember Cutrano to work with the petitioners to identify a temporary/pilot skate/scooter park location.

During Council's special meeting of February 17th, 2021, an ordinance was introduced to allow the Council, by resolution, to designate a portion of the Pavilion/Bank Street parking lot for use as a temporary skate, scooter, and in-line/roller skating park. At its regular meeting of March 3, 2021, the Council held the second reading of the Ordinance (Ord. 852) and adopted Resolution No. 21-08, designating the western portion of the Pavilion/Bank Street Parking Lot for use as a temporary Skate/Scooter Park and establishing rules and regulations for its use.

The Council approved the community skate park as a 1-year pilot subject to a 6-month checkin with the community and Council. Staff conducted a survey to aid PARC in evaluating the skate park's location, desirability, and value as a potential permanent Town facility.

DISCUSSION

On August 16, 2021 the Skate Park Survey was launched on Survey Monkey. It was promoted through the weekly Town Newsletter (ran for 4 weeks) and several social media posts (Instagram and Facebook). In addition, the community group that supports the skatepark

spread the word far and wide. The survey was open for four weeks, until September 10th. Results were presented to PARC at their meeting on Monday, September 13, 2021.

We received 219 responses to the survey (193 residents, 26 non-residents) of those responses we received 125 responses from parents/guardians, 66 responses from 18 and older, 19 responses from the 13–18-year-old group and 3 responses from the 12 and under group. The overall response of in favor of keeping the skatepark in the current location and making it permanent. 57% responded "yes", 27% responded "yes, with improvements". The combination for the "yes" responses results in an 84% positive approval rating. 16% of the respondents said "no" to keeping the skate park in the current location and making it permanent. Overall, the positive comments centered around gratitude for a safe, designated space for youth to spend time and be active. Many would like to see the park expand to include more space to skate and more features for a broader range of abilities. Those who do not support the current location or making the park permanent sited parking issues, litter and noise.

Survey results and comments are attached.

PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

At its September 13th meeting, PARC voted to accept the results of the skate park survey. Additionally, PARC re-iterated its recommendation that the temporary location of the upper Pavilion parking lot be the permanent location of the skate park. PARC requested that the Town deal with the issues of ADA accessibility, safety, parking and traffic circulation. PARC would also like to consider some of the suggested improvements to the skate park that were highlighted in the survey, such as handrails, shading and seating.

STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

Staff will return to Council with a proposed scope, schedule and budget estimate for making the skate park established in conformance with Resolution No. 21-08 a permanent Town facility at that location. Staff has already contacted the Risk Management staff associated with Sedgwick (part of the Town's insurance pool team) that assisted the Town Manager and Town Attorney in developing the Ordinance and Resolution that facilitated the temporary installation. Sedgwick has provided a certified playground safety inspector to review the temporary installation and advise as to any modifications warranted to make the installation permanent. Playground safety inspectors are certified by the National Recreation and Park Association (https://www.nrpa.org/certification/CPSI/). Similarly, the Town has received a proposal from a California-certified access specialist ("CASp") to review the temporary installation and advise as to any modifications warranted to make the installation permanent. CASPs are certified by the California Division of the State Architect (https://www.dgs.ca.gov/DSA). The Town's Interim Director of Public Works and Building Official will also participate in one or more of those inspections.

It is anticipated that any work necessary to complete the transition to permanent, if directed by the Council, will be adequately scoped and the costs estimated in time for Council's mid-year budget process.

FISCAL IMPACT

Staff anticipates minor costs associated with the CASp's services (less than \$5,000) that can be covered within the existing Department of Public Works operating budget.



Q1 Are voll a Fairfax resident? Are you a Fairfax resident?







Have you or someone you know used the new community skate park in Fairfax






