SUBJECT: Reorganization of the Town Council: Selection of Mayor and Vice Mayor

RECOMMENDATION

Select two Councilmembers to fill the two positions of Mayor and Vice Mayor.

DISCUSSION

Each year at the first Town Council meeting in December, the Fairfax Town Council rotates the positions of Mayor and Vice Mayor, selecting from among its members the new Mayor and Vice Mayor for the next 12 months. The objective is to provide an opportunity for all Councilmembers to serve as Mayor and/or Vice Mayor during their term of office.

The Council has complete discretion in selecting which of their number will fill these two positions. Typically, the current Vice Mayor is selected as the new Mayor. The current Vice Mayor of Fairfax is Vice Mayor Hellman.

The Vice Mayor position is generally filled by the newest Councilmember who has served more than one year, or the by Councilmember for whom the greatest amount of time has passed since she or he served as Mayor. Councilmember Cutrano is the newest member, having been elected one year ago, in November 2020. Councilmember Coler is the Councilmember for whom the greatest amount of time has passed since she was last Mayor of Fairfax (2019).

The new Mayor and Vice Mayor are seated immediately following their selection.
