The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the December 13th meeting were approved.

Jacqueline Engstrom gave an update on the Age Friendly Task Force. She stated the 90 plus celebration will continue to take place in November with gift baskets to residents.

New Business

1. Adoption of Parks and Recreation Commission Resolution 2022- -

Maria read the resolution of the Parks and Recreation Commission of the Town of Fairfax Making Findings and Determinations Under AB 361 for the continuation of virtual meetings. Roll Call: Ayes: Sisi Parry-Hanson, Dustin Liebman, Jacqueline Engstrom, Chris Borjjan. The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted at the regular meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission of the Town of Fairfax held in said Town on the 10th day of January 2022.

2. Open Time for Public Expression-Sisi announced that she Dirk Oooijkaas of Flying Dutchman gymnastics has approached her in an effort to find a temporary location for gymnastics during the Pavilion restoration. One consideration is the empty property at Fair Anselm Shopping Center. She will suggest that Dirk contact the owner.

3. Art in the Parkade proposal-Ross Asselstine attended the meeting to request producing a sculpture for the Rotating Art Exhibit in the Parkade. He has built many sculptures for Burning Man Festival. The sculpture he is proposing would be 8-10 feet high, and 3 feet wide. He prepared a miniature version of the sculpture and shared photographs with the Commission. Overall, PARC was impressed with the mock-up of the sculpture. **ACTION ITEM: Jacqueline made a motion to have Ross return to PARC once the sculpture is finished so they may vote on the final design; Sisi seconded, all Commissioners voted in favor.** In the meantime, the group will work on a foundation pad that can be installed at the site to support this and future sculptures.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
