RE: Archaeological Treatment Plan fulfillment for seismic retrofit of the Fairfax Pavilion

Dear Mr. Goldman:

Tom Origer & Associates proposes to complete work detailed in the Archaeological Treatment Plan for the Fairfax Pavilion Seismic retrofit project, as approved by FEMA and CalOES in November of 2020. This work can be completed under an amendment to the Consultant Services Agreement between the Town of Fairfax and Tom Origer & Associates Dated January 22, 2016.

The required work will be completed on a time and materials basis against a budget of \$161,000.00. This budget does not include a Native American representative, nor any expenses associated with use of construction contractors and their equipment. This budget also assumes that work will be completed when the project site soils are relatively dry so that "dry screening" is feasible and conducted at the project site. The above budget does not include any expenses associated with the use of an on-site or nearby secure laboratory space with running water, lights, heat, restroom.
