# **DISCUSSION**

There are currently up to 5 vacancies on the Climate Action Committee ("CAC"). Two applications have been received. The attached application is from Fairfax resident Nina Luttinger, who has attended at least one CAC meeting.

The CAC is comprised of at least seven and no more than thirteen members, who serve four-year terms. Members must be residents of the Town of Fairfax. The Committee was established to create and implement the Climate Action Plan, per the Conservation Element of the adopted 2010-2030 General Plan.
