Landscape Equipment Rebate Program Instructions

Terms and Conditions

- Rebates are distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis until all funds are expended.
- Rebate discounts are not to exceed the amounts listed in the table below.

Equipment Type	Residential Discount	Commercial Discount
Leaf blower	50%, not to exceed \$125	70%, not to exceed \$280
String trimmer	50%, not to exceed \$75	70%, not to exceed \$210
Hedge trimmer	30%, not to exceed \$55	50%, not to exceed \$200
Edger	30%, not to exceed \$30	50%, not to exceed \$150
Pole saw	20%, not to exceed \$60	40%, not to exceed \$300
Chainsaw	30%, not to exceed \$75	50%, not to exceed \$225
Push Mower	40%, not to exceed \$160	60%, not to exceed \$360
Riding Mower	10%, not to exceed \$300	20%, not to exceed \$1200

- Additional discount for commercial landscapers: 50% discount for up to two extra batteries with purchase of at
 least one of the equipment listed in the table, not to exceed \$500 in total. Alternatively, a 50% discount is available
 for a commercial backpack battery with purchase of equipment, not to exceed \$680.
- Limited to **two** units of equipment for **residents**.
- Limited to **four** units of equipment for **commercial landscapers**.
- Rebates are discounts at the point of sale at the participating location Fairfax Lumber & Hardware.

To Qualify for the Program

- Applicant must be a resident or commercial landscaper with at least one customer in Fairfax.
- Applicant must complete the online rebate program application and receive email approval from Town staff.
- Residents must provide a residential utility bill. Commercial landscapers must provide an active Fairfax business license or other documentation that indicates proof of having customers in Fairfax.

Application Packet Checklist

- Completed rebate application.
- o Approval email from Town staff.

Application Submittal

You will need to bring your completed rebate application and approval email from Town staff, along with your old, gaspowered landscape equipment, drained of any liquids, to Fairfax Lumber & Hardware. See page 2 for detailed instructions.

Rebate Program How-To

STEP I - WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO APPLY

- 1) Be a Fairfax resident or have a landscaping business with at least **one** customer in town.
- 2) Have at least one working, gas-powered leaf blower, string trimmer, hedge trimmer, edger, pole saw, chainsaw, or mower.
- 3) Be willing to trade-in your gas-powered landscape equipment for electric landscape equipment purchased from Fairfax Lumber & Hardware.

STEP II - HOW TO APPLY FOR THE REBATE

- 1) Read through the Town of Fairfax Landscape Equipment Rebate Program Instructions.
- Fill out the online <u>Landscape Equipment Rebate Application</u> (you'll receive an email with a copy of your application once it's submitted).
- 3) Wait to receive an email approval from Town staff after submitting the rebate application.

STEP III - HOW TO TRADE-IN YOUR GAS-POWERED EQUIPMENT AND BUY NEW ELECTRIC EQUIPMENT

- Print out your completed rebate application and email approval, and bring it with the gas-powered landscape equipment (drained of any fluids) that you wish to exchange for a rebate to Fairfax Lumber & Hardware.
- 2) Drop off your gas-powered equipment in the provided dumpster at Fairfax Lumber & Hardware. If you are dropping off any large, heavy equipment like a riding mower, make sure to give Fairfax Lumber & Hardware a call in advance to ensure they are prepared to receive it and have inventory for the applicable electric equipment. No other materials or products are allowed to be dropped off at Fairfax Lumber & Hardware.
- 3) Find the electric model(s) and any extra batteries you would like to buy in the store.
- 4) Let the sales clerk know that you plan to use the Town of Fairfax Landscape Equipment Rebate Program.

 The store will automatically apply your rebate during checkout.
- 5) Enjoy your new electric landscape equipment!
