SUBJECT: Adoption of a Resolution Adopting Fees for the Short-term Rental Program for

Inclusion in the Master Fee Schedule

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the Resolution Adopting Fees for the Short-term Rental Program for Inclusion in the Master Fee Schedule.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

At its meeting of June 1, 2022, the Town Council adopted Resolution 22-44, which provides the policies and procedures necessary to implement and administer the Town's Short-term Rental (STR) Program. The STR Program allows permanent residents in Fairfax to rent out specified residential dwellings for 30 consecutive days or less, subject to compliance with prescribed requirements including those related to occupancy limits and parking requirements. At its meeting of July 6, 2022, the Town Council adopted Ordinance No.865, which allows STRs in single family residential zones in the Town, and Ordinance No. 866, which establishes the STR Program. Both ordinances became effective 30 days after being adopted, and the provisions of the adopted Resolution are effective in support of these ordinances. At the January 19, 2022, Town Council meeting, a third-party administrator of STR Programs, Host Compliance, presented to the Council the range of services it could provide in support of the Town's STR Program. These services include the following: Address Identification; 24/7 Hotline Compliance Monitoring; Mobile Permitting & Registration; Rental Activity Monitoring; and Tax Collection. The Host Compliance services are primarily an online platform to coordinate the identification, registration, monitoring, initial enforcement, fee collection, and data collection activities involved with an STR Program. While the third-party contractor would provide a foundation for the implementation and administration of the STR Program, staff would still have a significant role in verifying registrations, responding to information requests and complaints, financial monitoring, business licenses, enforcement, and legal. The thirdparty contractor's services would be extremely valuable in identifying STRs in the community and providing foundational support and data collection to make the program successful. At the January 19, 2022, Town Council meeting, Host Compliance representatives indicated they anticipated their services would cost the Town approximately \$14,000.

Staff has followed-up with Host Compliance representatives to learn more about their services and requested a formal cost proposal. Host Compliance has submitted a cost proposal for the service areas listed above for a total amount annually of \$13,823.00. While the Host

Compliance proposal is firm, this is a new program and staff costs and associated program revenues can only be estimated. Staff estimated costs, proposed fees may not cover all program costs, and the Council may direct staff to review the program to adjust fees towards the end of the first year of operation when actual costs are more firm. As directed by the Town Council when adopting the implementing ordinances and resolution for this program, the registration fee will be waived for the first six months as an incentive to encourage registration of the STRs in the Fairfax community. Additionally, staff is recommending a relatively low initial registration fee of \$150 per unit. As a local example for comparison, the City of San Rafael charges \$170 for initial registration per unit, and \$135 for renewals.

FISCAL IMPACT

Staff expects that towards the end of the first year, there will be relevant information about both actual costs and revenues to adjust the registration fee as may be necessary. A combination of the registration fee, Hotel User Tax (HUT), general funds, and business license fees can be used to fund the program.

RESOLUTION 22-

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FAIRFAX ADOPTING A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FEES FOR THE SHORT-TERM RENTAL PROGRAM FOR INCLUSION IN THE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 50076 permits municipalities to charge fees for services or regulatory activities which do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing those services or activities; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has analyzed the Town's Short-term Rental (STR) Program ("Fee Estimate Worksheet for Short-term Rental (STR) Program, dated 9.1.22"), and determined a reasonable initial registration fee for the STR Program to be \$150 per unit; and

WHEREAS, registrants of the STR Program also will be required to obtain a Town business license and pay an annual Hotel User Tax (HUT).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax does hereby adopt and authorize the \$150 STR Program Registration Fee to be included in the Town's Master Fee Schedule.
