The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of the March 13th meeting were approved.

Age Friendly Task Force Update-Jacqueline stated that Age-Friendly Marin series are offered at the Fairfax Library.

New Business

1.Removable Mural for Pavilion wall behind the stage- Sam Parry attended the meeting to propose a mural of a Marin landscape scene he would like to paint that would be hung behind the stage of the Pavilion. The mural would consist of 4 panels. He will paint it off-site. Sam presented a mock up of the mural. Maria has run it by Loren Umbertis, Public Works Director, who inquired as to how it would be hung. Sam replied with a cupling plate and bolts that would be screwed into the wall. The mural can be removed anytime there is a function in the Pavilion where the rental party might want a blank background. **ACTION ITEM: Sisi made a motion to approve the removeable mural in the Pavilion; Lisa seconded, all Commissioners voted in favor.**

2.Youth Piano Recital on May 28th in Peri Park- Susan Pascal Beran attended the meeting and submitted a PARC application for a piano recital by Lindsay Albright. Lindsay had previously performed last summer in the park. The event will be from 2-3 pm on Memorial Day weekend. **ACTION ITEM: Sisi made a motion to approve this event, Jackie seconded, all Commissioners voted in favor of the event.**

3. Art in the Parkade exhibit proposal-Susan Pascal Beran offered to display one of her sculptures entitled "Skyplay" in the parkade lot. The piece will be ready to be installed in May. It will be up for 4 months, including during the Fairfax Festival. **ACTION ITEM: Jacqueline made a motion to approve the sculpture in the parkade, Sisi seconded, all PARC Commissioners voted in favor.** Susan also shared photos of a sculpture that the Carol Gold family would like to donate to the Town, for placement in the memorial section of Bolinas Park. Maria will discuss this idea with Town Hall staff, to inquire as to whether Town Council permission is necessary for this. This item will be heard at the May 8^h meeting.

4. Goals & Objectives for 2023- The group will postpone this item to the next meeting, so all members can be present for the discussion.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
