## **New Business**

- 1.Brewfest- Pavilion May 15<sup>th</sup>- David Smadbeck attended the meeting to request sponsorship of the Fairfax Brewfest, which will be held on Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> after a three year hiatus due to COVID. ACTION ITEM: Sisi made a motion to approve the event, Lisa seconded, all members voted in favor.
- 2. Fairfax Theater Company events- Alice in Wonderland Tea- March 19<sup>th</sup> from 2-4 pm Women's Club; Spring Play, weekends of April 8 & 9, 15 & 16, 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup>- Pavilion-Sisi announced that dates were scheduled for the Alice in Wonderland Tea, for which an Event Brite site will be set up for ticket sales. Additionally, she announced the dates for the Spring play by the Fairfax Theater Company.
- 3.Pickeball at the tennis courts Loren Umbertis, Public Works Director, attended the meeting regarding the tennis courts. He received clarification from the Ross Valley School District that back in the 1960's-70's, a written agreement was entered into between the Town of Fairfax and the Ross Valley School District, authorizing the Town to maintain the tennis courts. The only stipulation is that the Ross Valley School District gets first priority for playing on the courts. Loren has received an estimate from First Serve Productions to have the tennis courts resurfaced for \$28,800. That would allow for pickleball to be played on two courts and tennis on the other court. Currently pickleball can be played on one court and tennis on the other court.
- **4. Goals & Objectives for 2023-** Each member of PARC will bring one goal they would like to see accomplished throughout the year to the next meeting in March.
