The Recreation and Community Services Department serves the Fairfax population and beyond and provides all age groups affordable, fun programs, events, and opportunities to use Town facilities for gatherings and cultural events.

This Winter quarter, Fairfax Recreation and Community Services Manager:

- Planned for the upcoming spring and summer season, produced, and distributed a Spring/Summer 2023 brochure to all Fairfax residents and approximately 150 nonresidents.
- Hired spring and summer staff and independent contractors for our classes and campsincluding handling paperwork, schedules, registration, and budget.
- Hosted several ongoing classes, including a new partnership within Harmony Music to provide toddler and family music classes.
- We received rental income from our partnerships with CYO and Futsal groups, and birthday party rentals.
- Supported Age Friendly Fairfax committee by providing staff support for agenda, minutes and other.

- Met with and supported our Artist in Residence Collaborative with logistics and administrative guidance for current and upcoming events and offerings.
- Worked on budget, goals, and accomplishments for RCS department.

Additionally, Fairfax Recreation's Events and Volunteer Coordinator:

- Returned to in-person meetings for PARC in March now in the Women's Club for the first time since COVID.
- Recruited and received new Volunteer Board applicant to fill vacancy.
- Ordered and replaced No Smoking signs on Age Friendly benches throughout town.
- Met with Sean Youra, Paul Whang, Allison Ritter-Fitzpatrick and Larry Bragman to pursue "Rock the Bike" powered music amplification for Eco Fest stage at Fairfax Festival in June.
- Received event application from Archie Williams High School students Eco Action Club to host clothing swap in Bolinas Park on March 25^{th.}
- Hosted the "Alice in Wonderland" Tea Party at the Women's Club on Sunday, March 19th 2-4 pm courtesy of PARC and the Fairfax Theater Company
