Edible food recovery requirements





PREPARE



Since January 1, 2022, large commercial edible food generators (e.g., grocery stores and supermarkets ≥ 10,000 sq. ft.) have been required to donate their excess edible food to food

recovery organizations and/or food recovery services that would have otherwise been disposed.

COMPLY



Create contracts or written agreements with food recovery organizations and/or food recovery services to donate your business' excess edible food.



RECORDKEEPING

Maintain a copy of contracts or written agreements with food recovery organizations and/or food recovery services. Keep records of your food donation activities.
