Dear Jim:

You advised for the first time via a phone conversation, earlier this week, that you produced an initial study for the Pastori Outfall pipe on my property. With all the history and FOIAs and promises made by Michael Rock and Georgia McDaniels that I would be included in the process, I am more than disappointed that the Town of Fairfax again chose not to include me. As of this date you too have failed to provide me with a copy of your mitigated negative dec Initial study. You said that you are circulating it to others.

Please recall that the Town of Fairfax filed a false CEQA exemption on the Pastori pipe up to my bridge. The exemption used allows for replacement of a preexisting pipe not a capacity increase of 400%. The Town failed to incorporate baffles to slow the water down entering the creek at high capacity flows. The Town also failed to incorporate filters. Currently all the roadway hydrocarbons run unabated into the creek. When the swale between SFD and Center floods it allows raw sewage to float up from the underlying cleanouts and vents to again dump unabated into the creek through you new Pastori pipe.

The County and the Town have both acknowledged my ownership of the bridge through a recording of the bridge as my property. Yet to extend the pipe through my bridge will only serve to compound the erosion the Town created by dumping rocks into the creek breaking my foundation.

I also see that you placed this item at the end of the agenda 10:30pm to diminish public awareness.

You and the Town are not allowed to enter my property or touch my bridge. You are requested to provide plans for my approval that address how you plan to correct the foundation of my bridge that the Town broke which resulted in erosion to my property
Please provide a copy of your initial study with annotations and all supporting calculations with any and all EIR/CEQA reports and exemptions with proper citations.
