


Discuss Bond Measure for Road Repairs

Fairfax Roads -Now


- The Town scored a 55 out of 100 for our overall average Pavement Condition Index (PCI)
- Fairfax roads are ranked the worst for municipalities within Marin County
- Spending \$500K/year will result in a PCI of 51 over the next 5 years



*Developed by the U. S. Army Corp of Engineers during World War II and standardized by ASTM, the PCI is an objective and rational basis for determining pavement condition and establishing maintenance priorities.

Possible Solutions

- Continue allocating resources as available
- Increase revenues
 - Consider sales tax increase
 - Consider general obligation bond (Measure K example)
