This Fall, Fairfax Recreation hosted several classes and received rental income from its partnership with CYO, Futsal and our birthday party program. Additionally, we hosted several events including our annual 90 + event, Menorah Lighting, and the Fairfax Craft Faire, our annual fundraising event.

On November 4, 2023, Age Friendly held its 90 & Better celebration – this is the 6th annual event. Gift baskets were delivered to each of the participants (50 were identified; twenty-three participated). Included in the baskets were several gifts sourced from local businesses and programs, including greeting cards from Fairfax Open Space Committee.

On December 7th a menorah was placed in the Parkade by West Marin Chabad and a Hanukkah celebration in Bolinas Park took place on Thursday December 14th from 4:30-6:30 pm.

On December 9, 2023, we hosted the 13th Annual Fairfax Holiday Craft Faire and Wreathmaking event. We had over 85 applications this year. We hosted 37 vendors and 8 youth vendors in the Pavilion space. We invited A Fork Full of Earth to provide a menu of items including mac n cheese, chili, poke bowl, hot beverages/snacks and continued the tradition of having musicians perform throughout the day.
