

# TOWN OF FAIRFAX STAFF REPORT October 7, 2020

TO: Mayor and Town Council

**FROM:** Christopher Morin, Chief of Police

**SUBJECT**: Authorize the Town Manager to sign Amendment to extend Agreement for five years to provide dispatch services to the Town of Ross / Police Department

### RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Town Manager to execute an Amendment to extend the current Agreement to provide dispatch services to the Town of Ross / Police Department for five years from FY21-22 through FY25-26.

## **DISCUSSION**

Currently the Fairfax Police Department provides dispatch services to the Town of Ross / Police Department under a contract that is set to expire at the end of FY20-21. The current contract was a four-year extension of the original five-year contract entered into in July 2012.

Staff (i.e., Chief Morin) has negotiated a five-year extension of the contract. Below are the proposed annual payments. Over the five-year period, the Town will collect a total of \$66,000 more in revenue due to the increase.

FY 2021-2022 = \$56,000FY 2022-2023 = \$60,000FY 2023-2024 = \$65,000FY 2024-2025 = \$70,000FY 2025-2026 = \$75,000Total\$326,000w/o increase\$260,000Difference\$66,000

The Ross Town Council will consider this amendment at their October 8, 2020 meeting.

# FISCAL IMPACT

Under the proposal, the Town will receive increases of \$4,000 in FY21-22; \$4,000 in FY22-23; \$5,000 in FY23-24; \$5000 in FY 24-25 and \$5,000 in FY 25-26. Over the five- (5) year period, Ross' annual contribution will increase from the current \$52,000 per year to \$75,000.

The Town will see a gross revenue increase to the general fund of \$23,000 in year five of the agreement. This equates to an approximate 44% increase from FY21-22 (\$52,000) through FY25-26 (\$75,000)
