Basic Kit \$70

Basic kit includes tests for coliform bacteria, E.coli, and nitrate. Test every year.

Arsenic \$35

Testing recommended every 3-5 years.

Lead \$30

All homes built before 1987 should have drinking water tested for lead.

Iron/Manganese \$45

May cause aesthetic issues such as rust stains or a metallic taste.

Radon \$55

Radon in well water is a common issue. Test at least once.

Gross Alpha \$85

Gross Alpha is a test for uranium and radium.

PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances) - \$295
