Notice is hereby given that the said Ordinance will be considered for final passage at a public hearing to be held on June 22, 2017 at a meeting beginning at 7:30 PM at the Municipal Building located at 202 Sidney Road, Franklin Township, New Jersey, at which time all interested persons will be heard.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND ASPHALT OVERLAY OF OLD FRANKLIN SCHOOL ROAD AS A GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING \$140,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

- SECTION 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by the Township of Franklin, New Jersey. For the said improvement or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$140,000.00, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefore.
- SECTION 2. The Township of Franklin is hereby authorizes the drainage improvement and asphalt overlay on Old Franklin School Road in Franklin Township.
- SECTION 3. In order to finance the cost of the improvements or purpose there is hereby appropriated \$140,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund.
- SECTION 4. The said purpose described in Section 2 of this ordinance is not a current expense and is an improvement which the Township may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement.
- SECTION 5. The capital budget of the Township of Franklin has been adopted and conforms with the provisions of this ordinance.
- SECTION 6. There is no debt authorized for this improvement or purpose.
- SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage according to law.
