ORDINANCE 2018-03

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE 2005 CASE 580SM BACKHOE
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND
APPROPRIATING \$74,245.00 FROM THE CAPITAL FUND BALANCE.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this Ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey. For the said improvement or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$74,245.00, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefore.

SECTION 2. The Township of Franklin hereby authorizes the replacement of the 2005 CASE 580SM Backhoe in the Township of Franklin.

SECTION 3. In order to finance the cost of the improvement or purposes there is hereby appropriated \$74,245.00 from the Capital Fund Balance.

SECTION 4. The said purpose described in Section 2 of this Ordinance is not a current expense and is an improvement which the Township may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement.


SECTION 5. The capital budget of the Township of Franklin has been adopted and conforms with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. There is debt authorized for this improvement or purposes.


SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage according to law.
