**ORDINANCE 2018 - 15
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-03**

**ORDINANCE GRANTING RENEWAL OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT TO
COMCAST OF NEW JERSEY TO CONSTRUCT, CONNECT, OPERATE AND
MAINTAIN A CABLE TELEVISION AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM IN
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP, HUNTERDON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY.**

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2015 the Franklin Township Committee adopted Ordinance 2015-03 granting renewal of municipal consent to Comcast of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the Township Committees attention that the language in Section 7 of Ordinance 2015-03 is not consistent with the prior agreement and what was specified in Comcast's application; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Committee wishes to amend Ordinance 2015-03 so that the language in Section 7 is consistent with the prior agreement and Comcast's application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that Section 7 of Ordinance 2015-03 shall be amended as follows:

Section 1:

SECTION 7. EXTENSION OF SERVICE.

The company shall be required to proffer service to any residence along any public right-of-way in the Primary Service Area, as set forth in the Company's Application. Any extension of plant beyond the Primary Service Area shall be governed by the Company's Line Extension Policy as set forth in the Company's Application, with a HPM ("homes-per-mile") of 25 ~~35~~ dwelling per linear mile from the nearest active trunk or feeder line.

Section 2:

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon issuance of a Renewal Certificate of Approval from the BPU.

Section 3:

Severability. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or

clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4:


Repealer. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to their inconsistencies only.


