

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 56 "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES," ARTICLE VI "REGISTRAR OF VITAL STATISTICS," SECTION 18 "CREATION; DUTIES; COMPENSATION," OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN TO AMEND THE SALARY FOR THE REGISTRAR.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has reviewed the salary for Municipal Registrar for other municipalities in Hunterdon County and has determined that the current compensation should be amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee wishes to amend Section 56-18 prior to the hiring of a new Municipal Clerk.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey that Chapter 56 "Officers and Employees," Article VI "Registrar of Vital Statistics," Section 18 "Creation; Duties; Compensation," of the Code of the Township of Franklin shall be amended as follows:

Section 1:

§56-18 Creation; Duties; Compensation

There is hereby created the position of Registrar of Vital Statistics in the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey. The duties of the Registrar shall be as defined in N.J.S.A. 26:8-13 et seq. The salary for the position of Registrar shall be included in the Municipal Clerk's Salary. If anyone other than the Municipal Clerk shall hold this position, the salary shall be set annually by the Township Committee.

Section 2:

Severability. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3:

Repealer. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to their inconsistencies only.


Section 4:

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
