RESOLUTION 2018 – 18
(Amended)

WHEREAS, the Township of Franklin has petitioned the Superior Court of New Jersey for a Declaratory Judgment that its adopted 2018 Housing Element and Fair Share Plan is compliant with its constitutional obligation to provide its fair share of the regional need for very low-, low-, and moderate-income housing; and


WHEREAS, the Township's adopted 2018 Housing Element and Fair Share Plan will result in the creation of housing units affordable to and intended for occupancy solely by qualified very low-, low-, and moderate-income households; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin has determined to retain Cameron Keng as its Administrative Agent, to fulfill the duties set forth in Ordinance 2018-05 creating the role of Administrative Agent; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Keng shall be required to complete all training to achieve an Affordable Housing Professional Certificate, which is provided by the Affordable Housing Professionals of New Jersey and the Center for Government Services at Rutgers. This Certificate will serve as the qualification to serve as the Township's Administrative Agent. Mr. Keng shall obtain said Certificate by August 1, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon, that the Township of Franklin hereby retains Cameron Keng as its designated Administrative Agent.
