Finance, Administration, Insurance, HR/Benefits: Blew & Soloway

Discussion: Payroll issues - It appears there was a clerical error that resulted in the wrong payroll date printed on the checks. It was suggested that the payroll company be contacted and maybe if this occurs in the future they can run another corrected batch.

Discussion: County Records Storage – Our insurance company has permission from the County to tour the facility for liability purposes.

Public Safety (PD, Fire, EMS, OEM, Court, Health): Darocha & Fania

Lt. Timothy Snyder reported on police activities. Committee Member Darocha recommended that Lt. Snyder provide a written report when an officer performs outstanding service in order to make a public commendation.

Diane Laudenbach, CFO, advised the Committee that the auditors have determined that a Chapter 159 Resolution will be needed for a dedication by rider of e-ticket. Diane will have a resolution for the July meeting.

Discussion: Intent to remain in shared service agreement for the Municipal Court – The Township Committee discussed this request for a letter of intent to remain in this shared service so that negotiations for a new agreement may begin.

Motion to authorize a letter of intent be sent to East Amwell Township advising them of Franklin Township's intent to remain in a shared service agreement for the Municipal Court. This will be for negotiations purposes only at this time.

Department of Public Works: Repmann & Fania

Discussion: Proposal for Mason Dump Truck Ford F550 – The township intends to purchase this vehicle and Diane Laudenbach advised that a capital ordinance will be needed. There was some discussion about taking delivery of the vehicle in 2017 if it was ordered in the late fall. Diane advised the Committee that the funds to pay for the vehicle would still come from 2016 encumbered funds. The Committee seems to have a different understanding of funds from discussions with Heidi Wohlleb, auditor. There was further discussion regarding financing, bonding, leasing. There was discussion about funding the capital improvement fund, spending and replenishing. There were ordinances for road improvements over the years and after the money was spent insufficient money was put back into the capital fund so we're still trying to catch up. Fund transfers were also discussed.
