The Danger of Syringes and Lancets

If you need to give yourself an injection, proper disposal of syringes and lancets can be a problem.

The Community Safe
Syringe Disposal
Program ensures
those syringes and
lancets don't hurt your
family or the
environment.

You can assume responsibility for safe syringes and lancets disposal.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT CONTAINERS:

- 1 Without a cap
- 2 Overflowing with syringes
- 3 With blood droplets on the outside of the container
- 4 Other than ours



Getting Started

A one-time, non-refundable \$10 fee is required to participate in this program.

- You will receive an empty sterilized container with attached cap. While this container is made from a thick plastic material, we cannot guarantee that it is puncture proof.
- Place only used syringes (with needles), insulin pen needles and blood testing lancets in the container.
- After you have used a syringe, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO BREAK OFF THE NEEDLE OR DESTROY THE SYRINGE IN ANY WAY.
 Place the used syringe immediately in the container and keep the container out of reach of children and anyone in your home who may be confused or disoriented.
- When the container is ¾ filled, attach the cap and return the soiled container to the Center for Nutrition and Diabetes Management, Wescott Medical Arts Center, 9100 Wescott Drive, in the Wescott Medical Arts Center, Suite 102, between Hunterdon Medical Center and Sand Hill Road. Return hours are between 8:30 am and 4 pm Monday through Friday. We will take your filled container and give you a sterilized, empty container.
- Only standardized containers distributed by Hunterdon Medical Center will be accepted.
