RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RETENTION OF RAYMOND E. O'BRIEN, R.A. OF O'BRIEN ARCHITECTS INC. TO PROVIDE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES REQUIRED FOR THE DESIGN OF PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE NEW FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Township is in need of retaining a professional consultant to provide architectural services to the Township with regard to making improvements to the new Franklin Township Municipal Building on Landsdown Road; and

WHEREAS, said services shall not exceed the sum of \$49,800.00; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that a Resolution authorizing an award for the contract of professional services without competitive bids must be publicly advertised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, Hunterdon County, New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Township Committee does hereby approve the retention of Raymond E. O'Brien of O'Brien Architects, Inc., to serve as a professional consultant to provide the Township with design and construction drawings for the proposed improvements to the new Franklin Township Municipal Building;
- 2. Said firm is retained and hired without competitive bidding, as "professional services" under the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 of the Local Public Contracts Law specifically provides for the exemption of "professional services" from competitive bidding;
- 3. That the contract be awarded upon the issuance of a certificate of availability of funds; and {00749745-1}
