
WHEREAS, the Township Council further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey hereby recognizes the following:


1. The Township Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the North Hunterdon Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year 2024 in the amount of:
