**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND
AUTHORIZING THE SOLICITATION OF COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE
ALTERATION OF THE INTERIOR OF THE TOWNSHIP'S NEW MUNICIPAL
BUILDING, LOCATED AT 43 LOWER LANDSDOWN ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Township is the current owner of a parcel, located at 43 Lower Lansdown Road and known and identified on the Tax Map for Franklin Township as Block 8, Lot 1.02; and

WHEREAS, the Township intends to utilize the property as a site for the new Municipal Building; and

WHEREAS, the Township reviewed the plans and specifications in relation to the alteration of the interior of the New Municipal Building project; and

WHEREAS, the Township, after such review, is in approval of the plans and specifications; and


WHEREAS, the plans and specifications are attached hereto as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13, the Township is soliciting competitive bids to renovate the interior of the New Municipal Building.




