- ► Franklin Township has an ink cartridge recycling box in the township building lobby
 - All inkjet cartridges are accepted; toner and large format ink cartridges are not
 - Just drop your ink cartridge in the box. The Environmental Commission will do the rest!
- Alternatively, you can print a free shipping label from our host's website (<u>PlanetGreenRecycle.com</u>) and mail empty or unused cartridges in groups of 4 cartridges or more
 - Please include program identification number 31833 to ensure the township receives proper credit.
