#### **Administrative Matters:**

Meeting called to Order by Chairman Lyle Hoovler and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

- A. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>: Fritz Snyder made a motion to accept the July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 meeting minutes, as presented. Jill Dunlap seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.
- B. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Rob Horvat presented the Treasurer's Report. Dick Deiss made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. Fritz Snyder seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.
- C. <u>Approval of 2022 Budget</u>: Fritz Snyder made a motion to approve the 2022 Budget, as presented. Lyle Hoovler seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.
- D. <u>Delegate Selection Letters</u>: Fritz Snyder made a motion authorizing the Administrative Secretary to send the Delegate Selection Letter in December 2021 to all French Creek COG Members. Lyle Hoovler seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

#### Northwestern REC on Solar Panel Development

Rian Doubet and Steve Kargol of Northwestern REC presented information on Solar Panel Development from their perspective as representatives of an electric utility company. They provided a guidebook entitled "Zoning and Permitting Solar in Your Municipality" which may help municipalities facilitate standards in their communities. Rian Doubet noted Pennsylvania is the third largest provider of electric in the US, behind Florida and Texas. He noted of the 16% of alternative energy sources in PA, 6% of it is due to solar production. He and Steve Kargol reviewed the permitting process for both residential development and commercial development. Lyle Hoovler noted decommissioning is the biggest concern for large scale solar farms. Fritz Snyder questioned the costs and tax benefits. Brad Roae discussed natural gas, nuclear, coal and solar options and their importance on our electrical grids. Battery boxes, solar efficiency and amount of sun light in our area, regulations being adopted by some Crawford County municipalities and limits on the current electric company substations for development were also discussed.
